PROJECT HIGHLIGHT



NORWOOD HIGH SCHOOL NORWOOD, MASSACHUSETTS

Construction of the new Norwood High School is nearly complete. Agostini/Bacon Construction of East Providence, RI is the General Contractor for the project and the Architect is Ai3 Architects of Wayland, MA. The owner of the project is the Norwood School Department.

Lockheed Window Corp. acted as a sub-contractor for the project. The school was built directly behind the previous high school buildings which are being demolished.



The project consisted of 267 window openings, 3 curtainwall openings and 30 storefront frames with entrances. The windows, provided by Graham Architectural Products, were Series #2200H Single Hung window systems with exterior applied trapezoidal muntins. The curtainwall system was manufactured by Alumicor, Model 2500 and the storefront system was the Alumicor Model 3400 thermal storefront system. Alumicor also provided all the Rugged Wide Stile entrance doors. All materials for this project were supplied in the PPG Colonial White paint finish.
