

MARCH PROJECT HIGHLIGHT

CHARLESTOWN HIGH SCHOOL & PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE CHARLESTOWN, MASSACHUSETTS

Renovations are complete to Charlestown High School and the pedestrian bridge connecting the buildings located in Charlestown, MA.

The owner is the Town of Charlestown School Department and the General Contractor was Chapman Waterproofing of Dorchester, MA. The Architect of Design was CBI Consulting, Inc. of Boston, MA. Lockheed Window Corp. acted as a sub-contractor for the project.



The project consisted of 108 openings/550 Lockheed Series 6125 Fixed and Fixed over Project-Out window units. All material was provided in a clear anodized finish. An aluminum greenhouse system, manufactured by Alumicor, LTD was also included in the renovation. The pedestrian bridge and the student run Café were renovated with 1" insulated glass with a Solera colored interlayer of several colors. All classroom and administration area windows were provided with 1" insulated glass utilizing Okalux light diffusing glass. All of the window units were installed by Lockheed's certified installation crew.
